<p>Blue Lagoon Time: 4-6 hours</p>	<p>70 minute boat ride to the East: most popular Rangiroa destination, shark feeding, snorkeling</p>		<p>Visit "Shark City"</p>	<p>Sunscreen, snorkeling gear and/or water shoes</p>
<p>Ocean Reef Time: 2-3 hours</p>	<p>Explore the open Ocean Reef with all its life: by outrigger or an easy walk through water from Motu Teta, discover the "stoned" corals as well as the many reef fish and moray eels</p>		<p>Sunscreen, water shoes, not advisable for small children</p>	
<p>Toute Picnic Time: 4-6 hours</p>		<p>30 minute boat ride to Motu Tote to the West: uninhabited 9 Hectares island, enjoy exploring it and snorkeling around the surrounding coral heads</p>		<p>Sunscreen, snorkeling gear and/or water shoes</p>



<p>Aquarium Time: 3-4 hours</p>	<p>60 minute boat ride to the North-West: best snorkeling experience possible – period!
